The Patient Savings Card is a way for eligible patients to save on their out of pocket costs for the following prescriptions: EPZICOM[®] (abacavir sulfate and lamivudine), LEXIVA[®] (fosamprenavir calcium), COMBIVIR[®] (lamivudine/zidovudine), TRIZIVIR[®] (abacavir sulfate, lamivudine, and zidovudine), EPIVIR[®] (lamivudine), ZIAGEN[®] (abacavir sulfate), RETROVIR[®] (zidovudine), SELZENTRY[®] (maraviroc), VIRACEPT[®] (nelfinavir), and/or RESCRIPTOR[®] (delavirdine).

Reduced Cost Prescriptions are also available at retail chain pharmacies (such as Walmart, Walgreens, Target, etc.); supermarket pharmacies and at some privately owned pharmacies.

Free Drugs for Low-Income Patients

We have developed software for the prescription assistance program industry for the past five years. We often get calls from visitors to our website seeking information on drug company prescription assistance programs. Patients enroll annually and, if approved for the program, receive free medication delivered right to their door.
