

## COMPREHENSIVE SEX EDUCATION LAWS BY STATE

### PENNSYLVANIA

- ✗ Not required, but must stress abstinence
- ✓ Must include STI & HIV information and stress abstinence for prevention
- ✗ Sexual Orientation, Gender, & Consent teachings not required
- ✗ No regulation on medically accurate sex education

### STATE

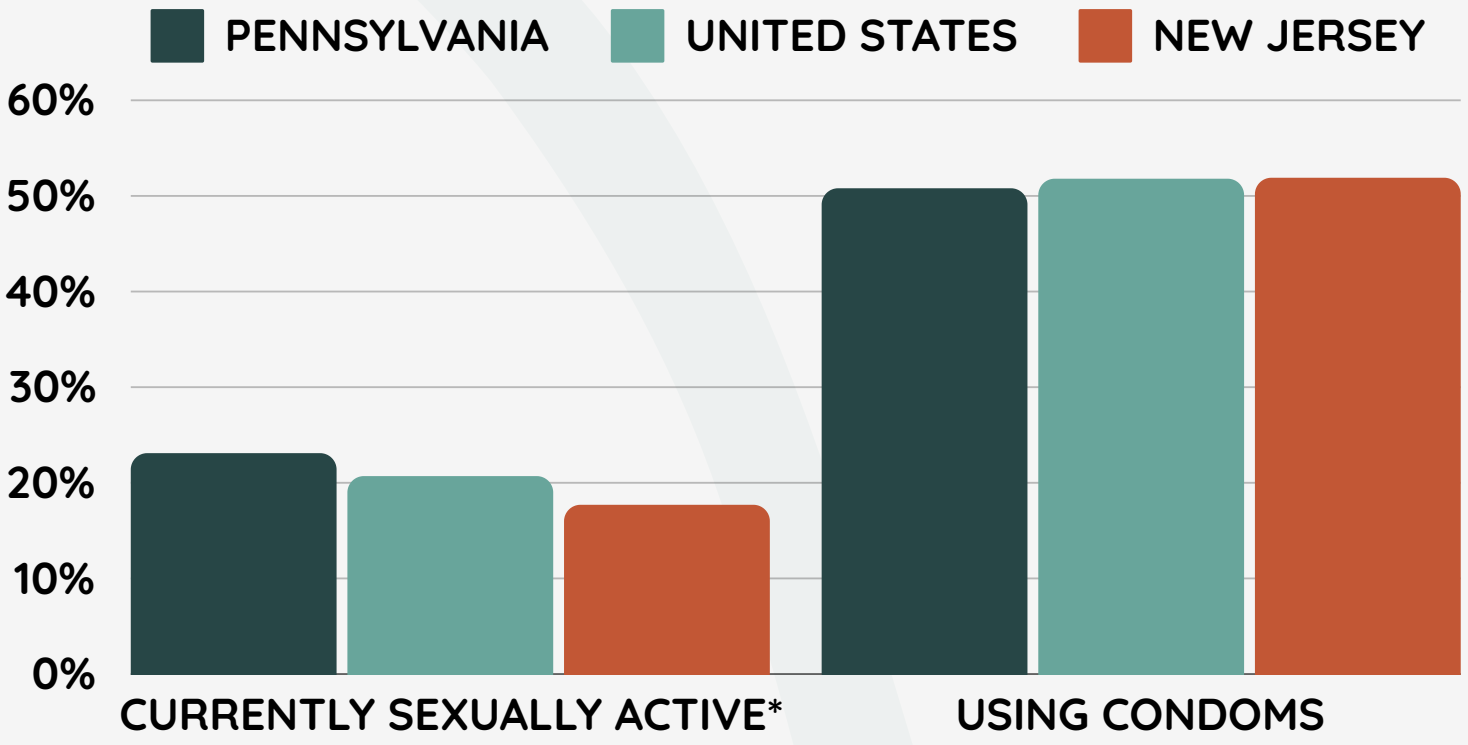
### NEW JERSEY

- ✓ Required, must stress abstinence
- ✓ Must cover condom use for STIs/HIV prevention
- ✓ Sexual Orientation inclusive
- ✓ Consent teachings required
- ✓ Medically accurate sex education required

NOTE: PA is among shrinking minority for no required comprehensive sex education
