To inform the development or update of the health department's Integrated HIV Prevention and Care Plan that will contribute to the reduction of new HIV infections in the jurisdiction.


Task – what is NJHPG asked to do?

To partner with the health department to address how the jurisdiction can collaborate to accomplish the activities set forth in the health department FOA PS12-1201.




