- 1. <u>Visit this page</u> (on health.pa.gov) to see where you can get vaccinated
 - a. Click on, "Where Can I get Vaccinated?"
 - b. After following this, you can view the interactive map -
 - i. "This map will be updated as more locations receive [the] vaccine. Click on a marker to see details on vaccination locations. Green dots indicate a facility has received [the] vaccine and may have vaccine availability and red dots indicate a facility does not have vaccines available."
 - c. Contact the location nearest to you with for information about receiving the vaccine

- 3. Select healthcare facilities, including many hospitals, are offering vaccines directly to their workers.
 - a. If you work at one of the facilities, you can contact your employer to learn if the vaccine is available to you from your employer.
